- This application form must be completed in full by the purchaser and signed as appropriate.

The application form, with Sections A to D completed shall be presented at the Authority for Transport in Malta, Vehicle Licensing Unit, A3 Towers, Arcade Street Paola or Malta Transport Centre Triq Pantar Hal - Lija between 7.30am and 12.00pm and between 1.00pm and 2.30pm workdays, to verify the eligibility.

- An applicant shall only be eligible for the grant if he/she resides in Malta;
- To qualify, the electric vehicle shall
 - not have been registered before the 1st January 2019 in Malta;
 - be licensed for private use or used in connection with the provision of voluntary services or the activity of a business;

For Private Individuals the grant will amount to:

- €7,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the M1 or N1 category while de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2, N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture.
- €6,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the M1 or N1 category without de-registering and scrapping an older ICE vehicle.

- c) €2,000 when registering an imported second-hand electric vehicle falling under the M1 or N1 category. The electric vehicle is not older than 36 months and should not exceed 15,000km on the odometer.
- d) When registering a new electric quadricycle or electric motorcycle falling under the L6e-B, L7e-C and L3e-A category the grant will be of 25% of the CIF value which amount will be capped to €6000. When de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2, N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture an additional €1000 will be given
- e) €400 will be given to private individuals purchasing a new pedelec (One)
- f) €2,000 will be given to private individuals purchasing a new cargo pedelec (One)
- g) €400 purchasing and registering anew electric motorcycle/ scooters/ mopeds /quadricycle falling under the L1e, L2e, L3e-A1, L3e-A2, L5e, L6e or L7e categories (one grant)

For Local Councils and registered Non-Government Organization (NGO's) the grant can amount to:

- a) €7,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the M1 category while de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2, N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture.
- b) €9,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the N1 category while de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2, N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture.
- c) €10,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the M2 or N2 category while de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2, N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture.
- d) €6,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the M1, M2, N1 or N2 category without de-registering and scrapping an older ICE vehicle
- e) €2,000 when registering an imported second-hand electric vehicle falling under the M1, M2, N1 or N2 category. The electric vehicle is not older than 36 months and should not exceed 15,000km on the odometer.
- f) When registering a new electric quadricycle or electric motorcycle falling under the L6e-B, L7e-C and L3e-A category the grant will be of 25% of the CIF value which amount will be capped to €6000. When de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2 N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture an additional €1000 will be given
- g) €400 per pedelec when purchasing of up to a maximum of ten (10) new pedelec (maximum grant €4000)
- h) €2,000 will be given on purchasing a new cargo pedelec (One)
- i) €400 purchasing and registering of up to a maximum of ten (10) new electric motorcycle/ scooters/ mopeds /quadricycle falling under the L1e, L2e, L3e-A1, L3e-A2, L5e, L6e or L7e categories (maximum grant of €4000)

Registered business and registered Private Companies, an amount of grant as stipulated in the De Minimis Regulations (i.e. a maximum of €200,000 (or €100,000 in the case of undertaking performing road freight transport for hire or reward) in de minimis aid per single undertaking over a period of three consecutive fiscal years) and grant can be availed with a mix and match of vehicles as follows.

- a) €7,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the M1 category while de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2, N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture.
- b) €9,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the N1 category while de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2, N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture.

- c) €10,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the M2 or N2 category while de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2, N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture.
- d) €6,000 when registering a new electric vehicle falling under the M1, M2, N1 or N2 category without de-registering and scrapping an older ICE vehicle
- e) €2,000 when registering an imported second-hand electric vehicle falling under the M1, M2, N1 or N2 category. The electric vehicle is not older than 36 months and should not exceed 15,000km on the odometer.
- f) When registering a new electric quadricycle or electric motorcycle falling under the L6e-B, L7e-C and L3e-A category the grant will be of 25% of the CIF value which amount will be capped to €6000. When de-registering and scrapping another M1, M2, N1 or N2 ICE vehicle which is at least 10 years old from its year of manufacture an additional €1000 will be given
- g) €2,000 per new cargo pedelec when purchasing of up to a maximum of twenty (20) units per company (maximum grant of €40,000)
- h) €400 per pedelec when purchasing of up to a maximum of twenty (20) new pedelec (maximum grant €8000)
- i) €400 when purchasing and registering a new electric scooter under the vehicle category L1e with up to a maximum of €200,000 grant (as stipulated in the De Minimis Regulation) to be used as part of an electric motorbike fleet
- j) €400 purchasing and registering of up to a maximum of twenty (20) new electric motorcycle/ scooters/ mopeds /quadricycle falling under the L1e, L2e, L3e-A1, L3e-A2, L5e, L6e or L7e categories (maximum grant of €8000)

State Aid
