## Notes for requesting a permit for a Personalised Reserved Parking Bay for Blue Badge Holders as per Legal Notice 174 of 2018

The procedure for a Personalised Reserved Parking Bays for Blue Badge Holders is managed and administered by the Traffic Management Division (TMD).

Permits will be given after consultation with the respective Local Council and the Commission for the Rights of Persons with Disability.

#### Who is entitled:

- Blue badge Holders;
- Relatives (father/mother/spouses/children/brothers and sisters), residing in the same address.

### What are the restrictions for getting a permit for a Personalised Reserved Parking Bay:

- If the Applicant's residence has a garage;
- If the reserved parking bay obstructs a high traffic area;
- If the reserved parking bay would be in front of third party garages;
- If the street is very narrow:
- If the reserved parking bay is less than 5 metres from the street corner;

## How to apply:

- The application for requesting a reserved parking bay, has to be filled up by the person with disability
  who needs to be a Blue Badge Holder (obtained from the Commission for the Rights of Persons with
  Disability, <a href="https://www.crpd.org.mt">www.crpd.org.mt</a>) or by relatives residing at the same residence;
- The applicant has to provide:
- a copy of the Blue Badge Holder's Identity Card or passport:
- a copy of the Car Log Book;
- a copy of the Car Owner's Identity card;
- a copy of the Blue Badge issued by the Commission for Persons with Disability (more information can be found through accessing <a href="https://www.crpd.org.mt">www.crpd.org.mt</a>.
- All documents have to match with the address of the requested communal reserved parking bay's address;
- The application is to be sent to Transport Malta, Traffic Management Divison, Second Floor, Pantar Street, Lija, LJA 2021 or by email: <a href="mailto:bluebadgeholders.tm@transport.gov.mt">bluebadgeholders.tm@transport.gov.mt</a>

#### The Process:

- Upon receiving the application, TMD, shall evaluate the applicant's information;
- If the application is according to the specifications, TMD shall proceed with a request for comments from the respective Local Council;
- If comments from the respective Local Council are not received within 4 weeks from the date of issue, TMD shall proceed to decide in favour or against the application according to the eligibility criteria of the Authority;
- If TMD decides in favour of the application, it will inform all parties concerned and implement the communal reserved parking bay as close as possible to the person with disability's residence;
- If TMD rejects the application, it shall immediately inform all parties concerned of its decision;
- Applicants that are no longer eligible for a reserved parking bay must immediately inform TMD so that it will take the necessary action to remove the bay;
- Applicants changing their address would need to file in a new application;
