Fireworks - Feast of Balluta - 2018

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies that fireworks display in connection with the village feast of Balluta will be let off from 2 pontoons moored in the middle of St Julians Bay.

The Pontoon will be moored in position "A" and "B" (as shown on attached chart) on Friday 27th July 2018 in the morning and will be removed on Monday 30th July 2018.

The dates and times of the displays are as follows:

Friday 27 ^m July 2018	from 2130 hours until 2230 hours
Saturday 28 th July 2018	from 2215 hours until 2330 hours
Sunday 29 th July 2018	from 1900 hours until 2300 hours

All vessels and bathers are warned to keep well clear and maintain a safe distance of not less than 60m from Pontoon "A" and 100m from pontoon "B" during the abovementioned days and times.

Mariners are to note the above and proceed with caution and at a slow speed on the given days.

The Pontoon will remain moored in position during the night and will have flashing lights.










